

Taspen Achieved 81% for GCG Score

Jakarta – Again, *Good Corporate Governance* (GCG) of Taspen is evaluated by the Development and Financial Monitoring Agency (BPKP). The second evaluation in 2010 for the period of 2009 raised five percent than the evaluation in 2009 for the period of 2008, it is 81%. Therefore there has been three times evaluation for Taspen GCG. The first evaluation is conducted by SPA Consulting in 2006 for the period of 2005 resulting 79% of score.

Evaluation for the implementation of Taspen GCG has been conducted based on assessment method and procedures as mentioned in the attachment of Decree of the Minister of State Owned Enterprise No.S-168/MBU/2008 dated 27 June 2008 regarding Assessment on GCG Program in State Owned Enterprise.

The evaluation on GCG implementation in Taspen covers five aspects namely the rights and obligations of stakeholders/RUPS; GCG policy; GCG implementation on Commissioners' organs, Audit Committee, Directors, Internal Monitoring Unit and Corporate Secretary; disclosure on information; and commitment.

Compared with 2008, implementation of Taspen GCG in 2009 is raised. This is marked with the raising score. This caused by the realization of GCG implementation by all Taspen board in running the company. **[fungsional GCG]**
